**Matters Arising**

- 12** The Rural Housing profile had been read by Kevin Harris, Peter Lindsay, John Lance and Bridget Evans and passed to Mike Moizer at the meeting. All that had read it had found it to be very informative.

The group again discussed the 'need' for affordable housing in the village at the present time and agreed it should look to any requirements for future development.

Kevin Harris informed the group of the current plans by the parish council and North Somerset council for tree planting along the A370 but not throughout the village.

**Any Other Business**

- 13** Kevin Harris reported on his attendance at the first Steerage Group meeting held on 4 March and the timescale for the questions to be included on the questionnaire to be submitted by 12 April.

The group discussed ways of delivering and collecting the questionnaire and the format of the questionnaire. Some concerns were raised as to distribution as not all members of the parish had received the 'flyer' for the Village Plan Meeting in January.

It was agreed that the group would concentrate on the following subjects:

Housing, Transport, Traffic Calming, Lighting, Footpaths, Trees, Open Spaces and Waste/Recycling.

Peter Lindsay distributed a map of the Parish marked up with existing and future possible footpaths, tree planting and sites that would lend themselves to enhancement. It was agreed that this would be very useful for inclusion on the questionnaire.
