**26 Village Plan Questionnaire**

The Learning and leisure throughout life action group, the Well-being and safety action group and the Environment action groups reported on their recent meetings to consider the Bleadon Parish Plan questionnaire. The following amendments were agreed:

- 1 Where ever person 1 – 5 is referred to throughout the questionnaire change to a – f.
- 2 Line spaces to be included after each questionnaire to allow for “comments”.
- 3 The map showing the settlement boundary be moved to the inside back cover of the questionnaire, so that it may be printed in colour to distinguish the settlement boundary.

- 6 The most up to date O.S. map available be used.
- 7 p.16 introduction to be revised using “plainer” English.

- 8 p.17 question 47 Delete “do you agree with this”.
- 9 Delete question 23

Other issues raised in discussion:

Education and provision of village school. Mr Arnold had written to Jo Gower-Crane advising the Leisure & learning group of his correspondence with North Somerset Council over the provision of school places for Bleadon children. Bruce Poole advised the committee that at no time had Mr Arnold approached the parish council formally over his school admissions concerns. It was agreed that the young person's part of the questionnaire should include a question – "Was this your first choice of school?"

Bruce Poole advised that the Parish Council had applied for a grant from DEFRA to help towards expenses in relation to the Village Plan process.

- 2) that 500 copies of the questionnaire be printed for distribution in September.
